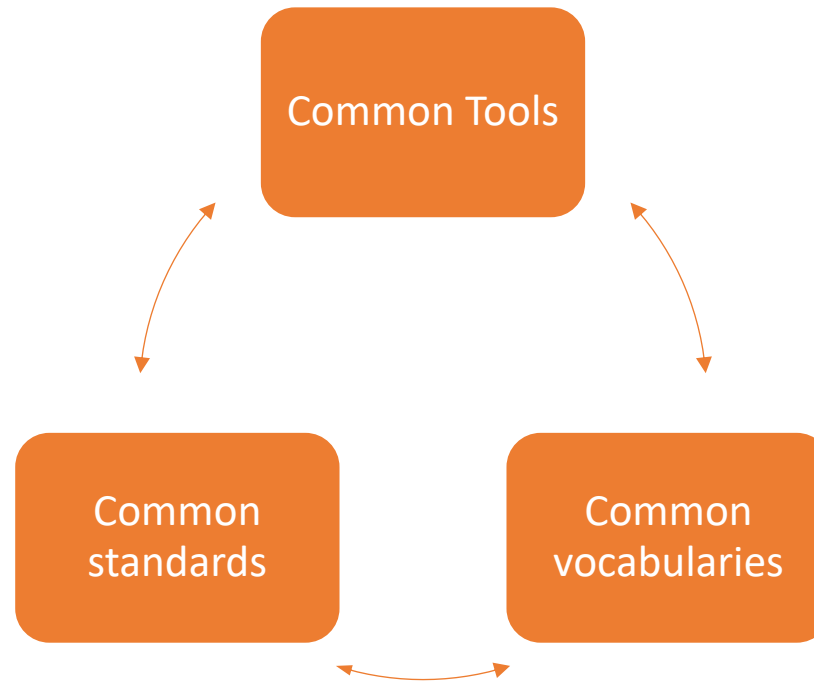

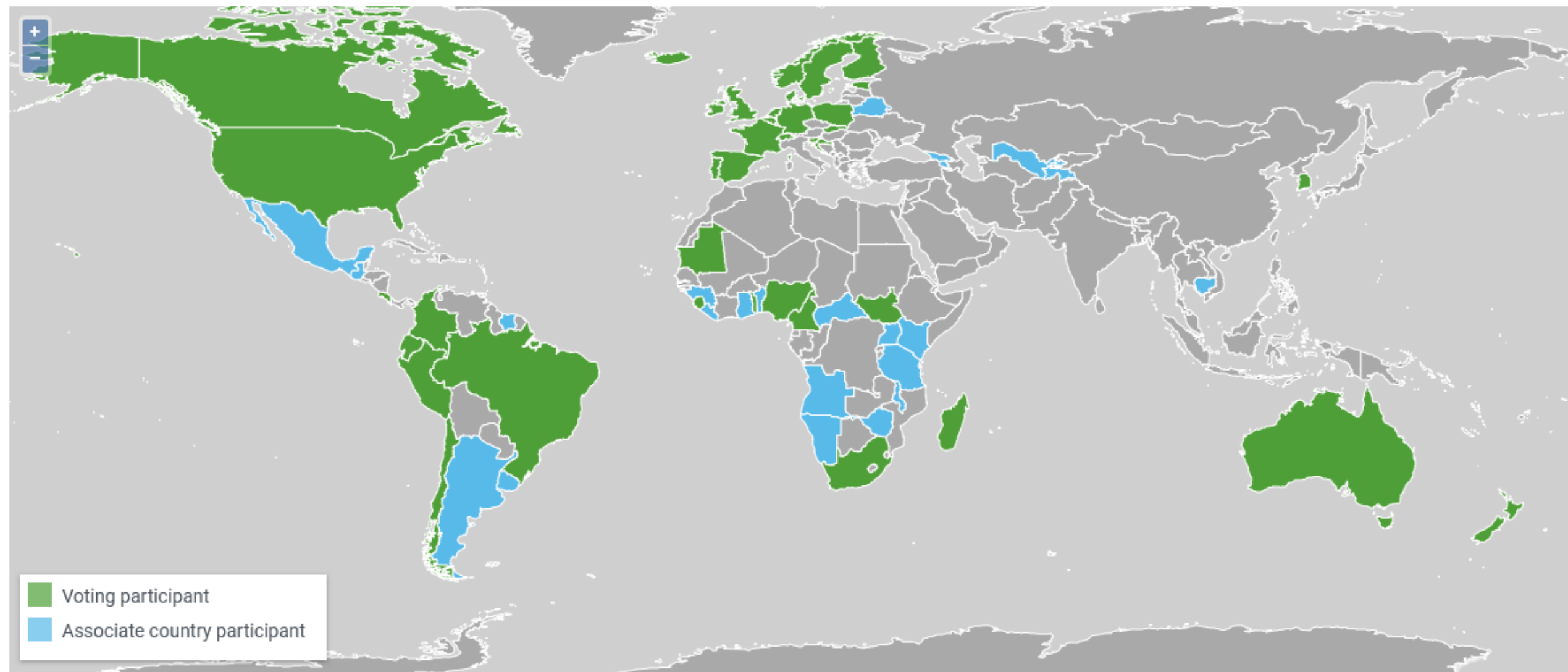
The Governing Board is the means by which GBIF Participants make collective decisions

# What governance?



Bern, 06.07.2016

Biodiversity data and information must be accessible and shared. This principle was behind the creation in 1996 of an international database called the Global Biodiversity Information Facility (GBIF).

The **Federal Council** today decided that Switzerland should become a full member of GBIF.

The Federal Office for the Environment is responsible for the implementation.

Info fauna is the contractor.
