The rock glacier of Lac des Vaux: hydrology, kinematics and anthropogenic impacts

A two-day excursion to discover and discuss the periglacial landscape of Lac des Vaux and its interaction with mountain hydrology is being organized by the Swiss Young Geomorphologists after the biennial conference of the Swiss Geomorphological Society in Val de Bagnes (Valais) next September. Specifically, we will stay overnight at Le Châble after the biennial conference concludes on Friday. On Saturday, we will hike to the Lac des Vaux rock glacier to discuss hydrological processes and anthropogenic impacts on those environments.

In recent years, several studies have been conducted on the rock glacier complex of <u>Lac des Vaux</u>. In this context, researchers have investigated the internal structure, dynamics, thermal state, and hydrological functioning of periglacial landforms. The excursion will focus on hydrological and kinematic monitoring, as well as anthropogenic impacts on periglacial landscapes with Dr. Sebastián Vivero, a senior researcher from the Alpine Geomorphology Research Group of the University of Fribourg.

Saturday 9 September 2023


Cable car from Le Châble to Les Ruinettes

Discussion about hydrological and periglacial processes and anthropogenic impacts on high mountain environments

Descent from Lac des Vaux to the cable car station at Les Ruinettes (~1h15)

End of the excursion around 16:00 at the Le Châble train station
