## Fund for the promotion of young scientists

The Swiss Society of Agronomy wants to promote young scientists. "Promotion of young scientists should make it easier for trained scientists to familiarize themselves with new fields, with new problems, and to acquire interdisciplinary methods. Therefore, they should be supported to participate in conferences, symposia, seminars and courses, also on an international level. In this way, the junior staff can acquire higher professional qualifications. Young scientists are an important asset in the balance of the sciences; only they can successfully face the great challenges of the coming years"

The SGPW-SSA General Assembly decides to open a fund for the promotion of young scientists. Voluntarily increased membership fees will be contributed to the fund. In addition, contributions from the Swiss Academy of Sciences as well as from the assets of the SGPW will source the fund. The contributions are to be paid to young scientists who actively participate in international scientific meetings.

The following conditions are attached to the payment of the contributions:

- The theme of the meeting must be related to crop production research and the development of crop production in the broadest sense.
- Active participation (poster, lecture)
- Submission of the abstract to the SGPW-SSA
- Submission of the budget for the conference costs
- Recommendation of the project supervisor
- The scientist should be younger than 30 years of age
- Submission of all receipts
- Presentation of the topic (in the form of a poster or an oral presentation) at the next SGPW annual meeting
- Recipients and supervisors are invited to become members of the SGPW-SSA.
