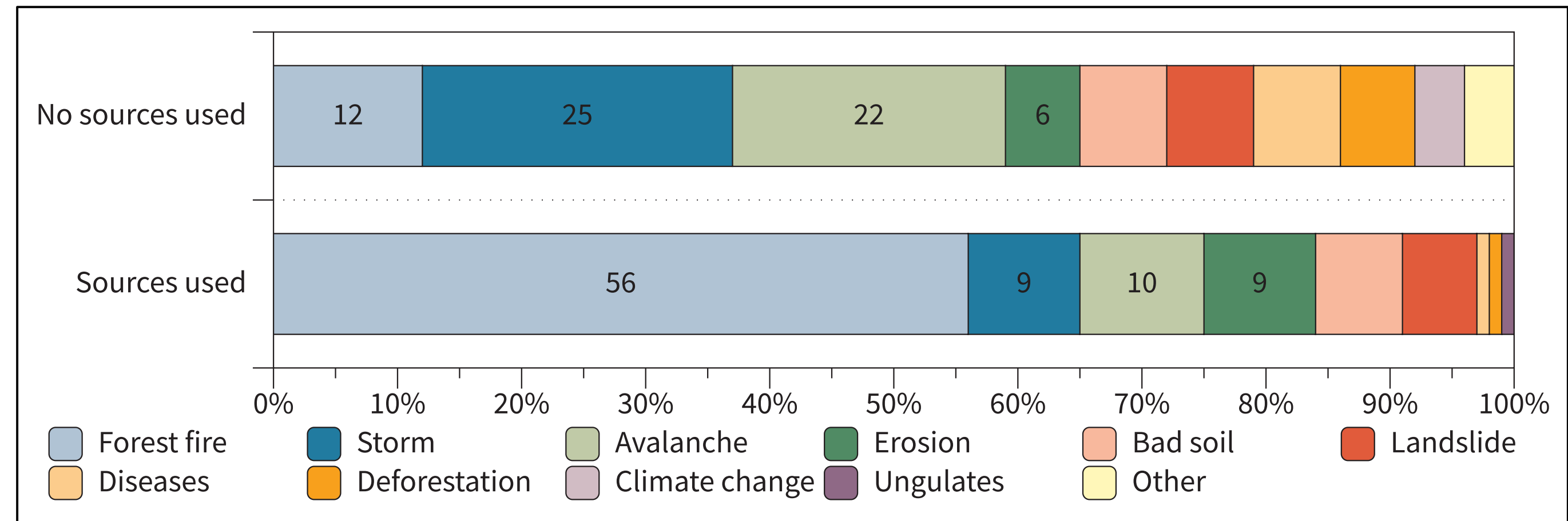


Fig 2: Less information sources coincide with more diverse explanations for the bare area

Sample

- 133 respondents, 72 male, 61 female
- Mean age: 47 years
- 15% were under 30, 75% between 30 and 70 years old
- 95% were from Switzerland.
- 1/3 first time visitors to SNP.

Conclusion

- Visitors should be animated to reflect on special landforms such as the bare slope.
- Such features can be used to inform visitors about past and future landscape changes (e.g. by comparing old and new photos, as in SNP's current exhibition).
- Information should be provided close to the phenomenon (e.g. using localising apps, QR codes, information boards, exhibits).
