Presentations

This year, we will host a diverse set of presentations:

Hans Richner (ETH Zurich) will provide some historical remarks on atmospheric electricity,

Saskia Willemse (MeteoSuisse) will speak about her personal experience at the Weather Service of Bhutan,

Hilmar Hofmann (Univ. Konstanz) will give some insights on wave modeling on Lake Constance based on COSMO winds and

Marie-Estelle Demory (Univ. Bern and Reading) will present recent challenges and advances in high-resolution global climate modeling and its applications to climate services.

The presentations will be held in English.

Table Talks of Master projects

As in recent years there will be table talks where Master students from around Switzerland will present their work. The talks will last about 10 min. and the participants are invited to join this informal setting to learn more about the different projects, ask questions and provide some hints to the students.
