Key insights so far...

- ❖ Decolonization to transform the *terms upon which universities exist in theory and praxis*
- ❖ Critique Western knowledge systems and their claim to universality
- ❖ Address “epistemic violence” (Heidi Mirza) of dominant hegemonic discourses
- ❖ Curricula and Pedagogy- primary sites where these discourses are reproduced
- ❖ Education theorized to “transgress” boundaries proscribed by systems of oppression (bell hooks)
