SSPM Poster Award at SSPT Spring Meeting

Pharmaceutical Medicine is a medical-scientific specialty whose purpose is to provide the best possible therapeutic coverage for the benefit of patients and society through medical need-based development and optimal use of medicinal products. It covers the area of discovery, research, development and approval of new medicinal products, as well as safe and effective use of new and established medicinal products in daily clinical practice. Patient-centered, evidence-based decision process is at the core and has a direct influence on the therapeutic coverage of patients, potentially beyond the Swiss healthcare system.

The Swiss Society of Pharmaceutical Medicine (SSPM) promotes and recognizes the scientific work done by physician trainees or young specialists (≤ 40 years of age) in our discipline. The SSPM Poster Award (CHF 500) is devoted to the first author(s) for best poster or oral presentation at the Annual Spring Meeting of the SSPT on a topic related to the core areas of Pharmaceutical Medicine. This includes (1) discovery of medicines and early development, (2) clinical development and clinical trials, (3) medicines regulation, (4) drug safety surveillance, (5) research ethics and participants protection, (6) socio-economics of the healthcare system, and (7) communication and management.

The following kind of works are eligible: primary and secondary data analyses, review articles, case reports and description of new concepts. Encore abstracts are permitted (if primary publication is not older than 18 months).

A scientific committee will select the best work considering the current or future impact for the benefit of patients and society.
