


"Access to information and communication technologies, particularly broadband, has the potential to serve as a major accelerator of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.


Young Internet users...

Proportion of youth (15-24) using the Internet, 2017 (estimated; ITU 2017)




... compared to total population

Funding framework

- Federal project contributions
- → An instrument of the Confederation to support targeted programmes of Swiss-wide relevance in higher education policy.
- Political decision to define development and co-operation as a priority and a mission for Swiss higher education institutions.
- Launch of the SUDAC Programme for a 4-year period (2017-2020) with a total funding of 8 million CHF (50% financed by the Confederation).
