# 6. CHIPP Board/Plenary Organization

AS reports on the scientific part of the CHIPP Annual meeting. The only missing speaker is the XENON one; Laura Baudis will provide a name. The young researchers are organizing their "flash talk" speakers

and the poster session. AB will follow up with the young researchers about the presentation from the Institute representatives.

#### 7. Flare Panel Results

CHIPP received the outcome of the FLARE funding; the funding attribution between CHIPP and CHAPS project is about 85% to 15%. Each FLARE PI received the outcome, which will be discussed at the CHIPP Board the 10 June (to be decided at next EB). There were cuts in the core requests, which will need to be discussed with the experiments. The continuity of the projects needs to be secured following both the European Particle Physics Strategy and the Swiss Institutes/Universities research directions.
