6. Report SCNAT meeting 28/05

Marc Türler has been appointed Head of the Science Division and he will continue to be Head of the Platform MAP. A new position has been opened in the SCNAT as scientific collaborator at 50% with a Master's in Mathematics or Physics to collaborate with Marc in his tasks.

The funding requests 2022 ("Beitragsgesuche" / "Demandes de subventions") deadline is set for Monday, 16 August 2021.

7. CHIPP Board/Plenary Feedback

Third party finance Working Group:

AS reports that she was contacted at the CHIPP meeting in Spiez by some Board members interested in joining the Working group, as discussed at the last EB meeting; MW, AS and GI will lead the working group. A first plan is to:

- fix a first date for a kick-off meeting (suggested the 7 October at 10:15) to formalize the creation of the group
- collect information about successful and unsuccessful grants from the PIs to produce some solid plots on the success rate as a function of time (year of submission)
- o extract the available information from the P3 SNSF database
- collect feedback and comments received from the funding agency as a justification for the cut or the complete rejection of a project
- o counter-propose to the SNSF some alternative strategies to cut/select projects; in the UK, for example, there are two types of funding schemes for funding positions: one with very high priority for so-called "ring fenced" position, tightly connected with MoU commitments with an experiment or with important responsibilities taken by the Institute; a second one with a lower priority but with a wider choice of research plans. Another issue worth discussing is to suggest to the SNSF the elimination of the criteria of "not overlapping" grants.

Financial Income/outcome

AB is waiting for the invoice from the Hotel Seaside. AB sent the invoice to the participants and Institutes; she will report about the final accounting at the next EB meeting.

8. SCNAT funding requests

- Dialog: Katharina Müller joins the EB meeting; she explains that it is a change is expected on
 the way to organize the scientific articles CHIPP normally writes and distributes. It would be
 interesting to have somebody that has access to journals to have a wider distribution of the
 articles. Splitting the budget for video production and press/article should also be considered.
 For this reason, the request for funding to the SCNAT this year should be formulated in a way
 to keep open the modus operandi for the 2022.
