Awarding outstanding Swiss PhDs in natural sciences

Call 2024

The Prix Schläfli, one of the longest-running science prizes in Switzerland (since 1866), is awarded by the Swiss Academy of Sciences (SCNAT) to young scientists for excellent articles resulting from PhDs in each of the following disciplines:

- Biology
- Chemistry
- Geosciences
- Mathematics

Eligibility is limited to young researchers who did their doctoral thesis at a Swiss University, or Swiss nationals who did their doctoral thesis abroad. Candidates must have defended their doctoral thesis between 1 November 2020 and 30 November 2023. Nominations may be submitted by the candidate's doctoral supervisor or by the president of an SCNAT member society.

A jury is established for each of the four disciplines in order to evaluate the nominations. Prize consists of CHF 5000 and support for conference participation in one of the scientific fields.

Nominations are submitted via an online form **before 30 November 2023** (scnat.ch/prixschlaefli). Please consult the guidelines before applying.
