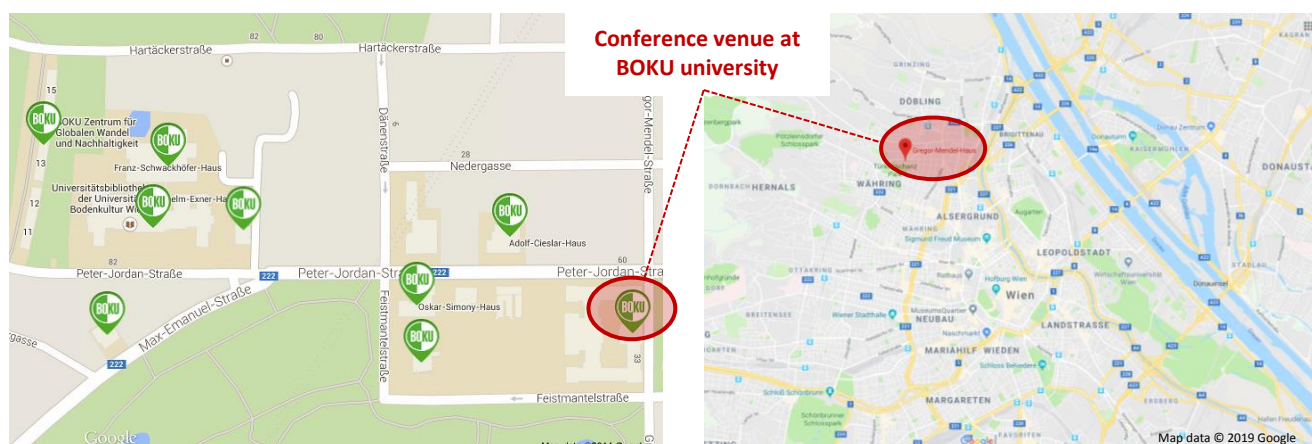

BOKU University Vienna can conveniently be reached by public transport from all major train stations and from many hotels. The bus lines 40a, 37a (stop *Linneplatz*) and 10a (stop *Dänenstraße*) have stops directly at BOKU University. From Vienna central train station (Wien Hauptbahnhof): take the subway lines U1 and U4 and bus line 37a. From the train stations Westbahnhof and Wien Meidling: take subway line U6 and bus line 40a.
