This event celebrates Röntgen's 175th birthday and the 125th anniversary of his discovery of X-rays, it was moved to this year from 2020 and it will take place at **ETHZ Höggerberg on Saturday 18 September**.



Five distinguished speakers will take part in the symposium and will cover the history of Röntgen and the origin of his discovery as well as modern applications ranging from X-ray detectors, X-ray lasers to X-ray astronomy, that impressively illustrate how big Röntgen's impact still is in today's research and technology.
